 - Provide a short biography summarizing your artistic and/or professional qualifications and achievements. Do not copy your resume/CV or include any website links.
- Please tell us about any contributions you have made to your artistic or professional field (e.g. teaching, new methods, new ways of thinking about a form, scholarship, or community engagement).

Proposed Cultural Exchange Activities

- Provide a summary of your New York Fellowship proposal in 3 sentences or less.
- Describe your proposed New York Fellowship activities in detail and explain what knowledge or experience you hope to gain from engaging in cultural exchange. (max 800 words)
 - When describing your fellowship plans, remember to answer basic questions, such as: who, what, when, where, why, and how? Be sure to thoroughly explain what you wish to gain from your proposed cultural exchange activities. Avoid the use of jargon or abstract and conceptual language to ensure that your proposal is clear and detailed.
- Describe the feasibility of your proposal. Identify potential challenges to conducting your proposed activities and how you might address them. (max 200 words)
 - We understand that you cannot fully predict all roadblocks to living and conducting research in a new country, but please communicate any issues you foresee and how you plan to mitigate them.
- List any contacts or connections in the destination country/countries and how they might support your proposed activities.

- What impact do you anticipate making on your communities, your artistic/professional field, and/or in the creation of new resources by engaging in a cultural exchange experience? (max 300 words)
- Please tell us about ways in which your artistic or scholarly practice engaged with communities and built connections locally and/or beyond. (max 200 words)
 - Provide concrete examples of previous experiences or initiatives where you successfully fostered long-term partnerships.

Ability to Communicate in Prospective Country
